CALL TO

VILMA LUZ GARCIA GONZALEZ QUALITY AWARD 2024

The Vilma Luz Garcia Gonzalez Quality Award of the Mexican Institute of Quality Control, A.C. IMECCA A.C. is awarded annually by the Agapito González Foundation for the Promotion of Quality to the professional woman who has most distinguished herself in the promotion of quality and safety techniques and their application to the Mexican industry. Guatemala and/or Cuba. From 2024, the Award is open to other countries in Latin America, as well as in the Asia Pacific region

The award is given to only one professional woman per year who must not have received the same award before.

The call for this award is open during the beginning of the year until July 31 of each year, to present candidates. The announcement of the winner will be made at the beginning of September and will be presented within the framework of the National Congress of Quality Control that takes place every year starting on the 1st Wednesday of October of each year.

Requirements to be considered as a candidate for the Award.

1. Be nominated by one IMECCA member and supported by 4 other members.
2. Have a track record that meets the selection criteria.
3. Have carried out their dissemination work mainly in Mexico and/or Latin America or a country in the Asia Pacific region.
4. Have a professional activity in the field of quality, plant management and/or general management of at least 10 years.

Considerations for selecting the winner.

1. Degree of personal involvement in the dissemination of quality as a teacher, instructor, author, speaker at National Quality Control Congresses and/or columnist in magazines and newspapers.
2. Nominee's personal values.
3. Contribution to the advancement of quality science and technology in Mexico.
4. While the nominee has been contributing to the spread of quality.
5. Contributions to the dissemination and advancement of quality science and technology in Latin America and the Asia-Pacific region.
